Location/Production

- Since 1918, Château Buisson-Redon has belonged to the SEZE family that also owns Château Mayne-Vieil in the Fronsac AOC. The family has reconstituted the property after world war 1 and is particularly attached to the production of high-quality red wines. The vineyard is grassed, stripped on one side and harvested green for better aeration of the bunches and to reduce the yield.
- The maceration takes place in thermo-regulated vats.
- 15% ageing in oak barrels.

- · Aromas black fruit, cocoa, leather, earthy notes.
- Leather, black currant, chocolate, bell pepper, medium acidity and tannins.







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
