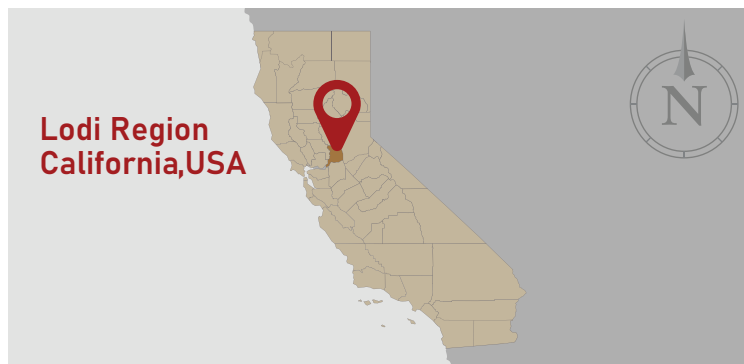

Location/Production

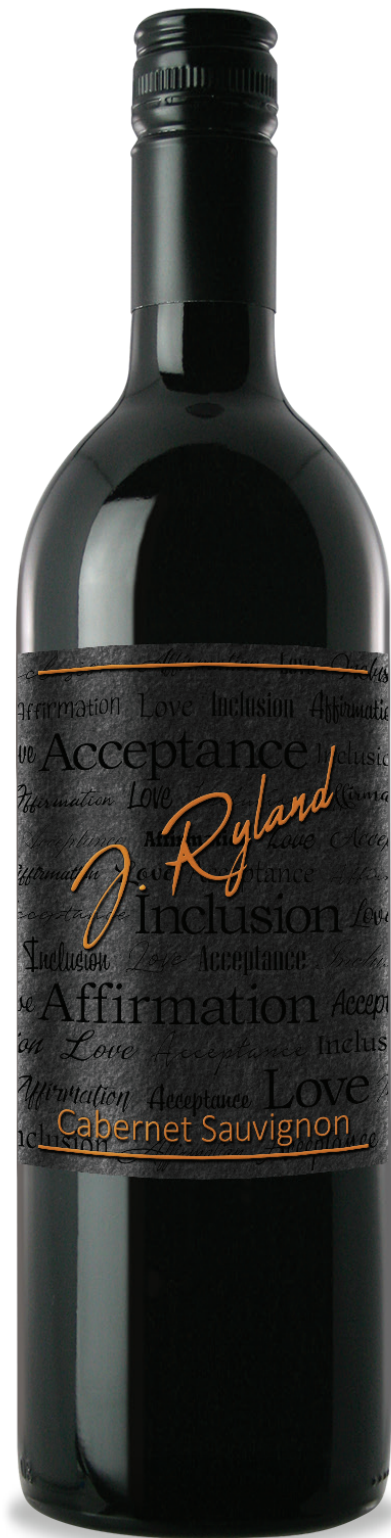
- The J Ryland Cabernet Sauvignon varietal vineyards are located in the Lodi Region of California.

- The grapes are cultivated to have a balance between fruit character and structure.
- The J Ryland Cabernet Sauvignon varietal grapes are harvested at optimal ripeness, crushed, and fermented in stainless steel vessels.
- Our Varietal is aged in experienced barrels for twelve months.

Color, Nose & Palate

- Our J Ryland Pinot Noir has a dark garnet color with aromas of fresh-cut Rosemary, Thyme, and Bay Leaf, Raspberries and Blackberries.
- This medium-bodied wine gives way to a delightful coco powder finish.
